Praise/Prayer – Tolsey continues to heal from her amputation. Pray for her and Pastor Nekelsen as he will be returning to the church in Malfakau and she will be remaining here in Port Vila for ongoing care and recovery. We are praying that she will be able to have a prosthetic leg provided early next year.

Praise – All the tests and scans in New Zealand came back clean and clear. This is truly a blessing, but it does leave unanswered questions. We now know all the things it is not. Please continue to pray for a resolution as treatment continues.

Prayer – Please pray with us as Ari and I return for a very brief trip to the US to see my mother and report back to our home church. This will not be a furlough, but a medical check-in and visit.

Prayer – We have many in services who are in need of salvation. Several who have clearly declared so, but are allowing the fear of family and other pressures to keep them from making their decisions. Pray that they would hear God's Word above all others.

Prayer – We still need a new teacher trainee and/or assistant to surrender to this ministry. God has always provided from His people here and we pray and trust that He will do so again!

Praise – Thank you for praying for the young men saved in Erromango. We have seen them continue in discipleship with Steven and in church services here in Port Vila. What a blessing it is to see effectual fruit through God's Word!
